


Sign Permit & Installation Guidelines

- The amount, type and location of signs allowed on a property is dependent on the zoning designation of that property. See Article IV, of the Zoning Ordinance (Chapter 50 of City Code) for requirements.
- Private signs (commercial and non-commercial) must be located outside of the public right of way and must
 meet any property setbacks unless granted a variance. Any sign proposed to be located within a right of way
 must be approved by the road jurisdiction (City, County, or State).
- Unless installed by the property owner, the city requires a licensed sign installer for installation of all signs.
- A sign permit shall become void if installation is not complete within 180 days of the date of issue.


Sign Dimensions

Sign Face






Sign Structure




Individual Letters (sign face)
