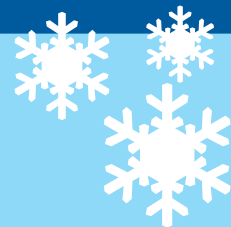

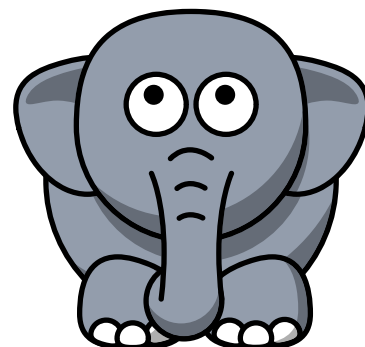
WINTER STATS

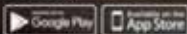
