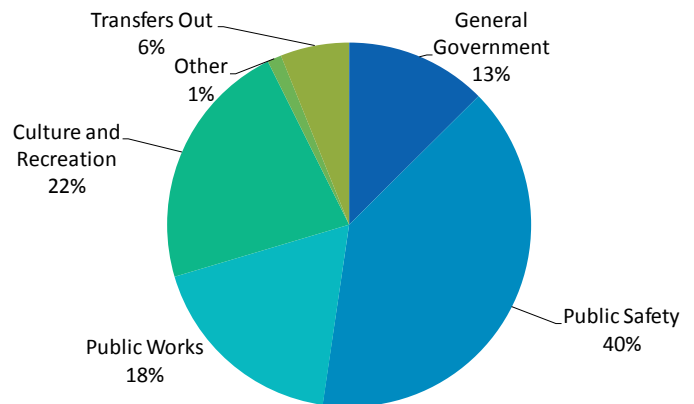

The City Council recently adopted the 2018 Preliminary Budget and Property tax levy. The initial levy reflects a 2% increase, due to the rise in the debt service. This money is used to build new and maintain existing infrastructure.

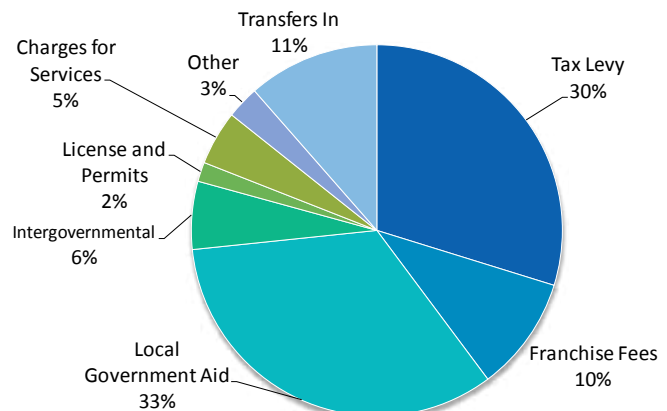
The general levy remains unchanged for the 6th year in a row. City staff works to find innovative solutions to keep costs down while maintaining a high level of service and staffing.
